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

National landscape of state actions





Vehicle Permitting

- Application process for issuing a permit for individual companies or individual vehicle designs before allowing the testing of a vehicle
- Those jurisdictions requiring an application process expect:
 - Contact information for company representative
 - VIN specific data of the vehicle(s)
 - geographic location of testing
 - Individual drivers





Registration Credentialing

- Some jurisdictions require special vehicle registration credential indicators
 - "Standard" issue plate versus a testing plate (manufacturer or special AV plate)
- Credential may limit the location of use (highway only, permitted authorization, etc.)
- Prohibit operation in certain weather ODD limitations based on application requirements





Titling Varies by Jurisdiction

- Some jurisdictions require vehicle title branding
 - Limit future use of the vehicles
 - Require specific disposition or return of the vehicle to country of origin





Financial Responsibility

- Require special liability coverage
 - Levels
 - Risk categories





Federal Vehicle Standards

- Limitations on the number of alterations of federally approved safety systems
- Disclosure of alterations
- Recognition of new vehicle designs
 - Shuttles
 - Package delivery vehicles





Driver Credentialing

- Some jurisdictions require the disclosure of those operating/monitoring the vehicles – indicated during permitting process
- Some jurisdictions require licensure restrictions or limitations
- Prohibit certain types of individuals from participating in testing





Driver Training

- Some jurisdictions require the disclosure of company training of the operators/monitors of the vehicles
- Some jurisdictions require jurisdictional (DMV/DOT/Law Enforcement) input or participation in the training





Training

- Delineated points of emergency contacts for companies
- Require special training or documentation on how to handle/interact with the vehicles
- Require input from state entities related to training and documentation









Engagement Plans

- Require plans to address known situations
 - Crash response and mitigation
 - Inoperable conditions
- Require state input in testing program process
 - Route assessment and approval
 - Local jurisdictional interaction partnerships







Vehicle Reporting

- Special vehicle crash reporting
- Disengagement/unexpected situation reporting







- Heading up Leadership
- Communication between government agencies
- "What ifs" to consider
- Economic issues
 - Jurisdictional investment
 - Work force development
 - Infrastructure development







- Preemption
- Local road usage and awareness
- Platooning
